English: We watched the story of *The Way Back Home* and orally retold the story, using the past tense. We used a range of question starter words to write our own questions for the main characters.

Maths: Using our understanding of place value, we added ones to two-digit numbers, noticing how the tens number doesn't change. We also investigated efficient ways of adding three one-digit numbers and bridging to the tens number first when adding.
